Stakeholder consultation to convert to an academy within a multi-academy trust

You may be aware that in recent years there have been significant changes to the educational landscape. At Rowner, we want to continue to secure the best future for our pupils, families and local community, building upon the improvements we have already made.

Following careful consideration and investigation into a range of options, the governing body have unanimously voted to begin a formal consultation process about the proposal to convert to an academy with a preference for joining the Gosport and Fareham Multi-Academy Trust (GFM). The GFM includes Bayhouse, Brune Park, Gomer Junior School and Lord Wilson. In considering this conversion, the over-riding concern of governors is to ensure that our school continues to provide the best possible standard of education and care for our children.

Key points of joining the multi-academy trust:

- Kerry Payne will continue to lead the school on a daily basis and members of our governing body will join the Primary Local Governing Committee (LGC), which has the overview of the primary schools within the GFM.
- Rowner Junior School will not change its name or ethos.
- The school uniform remains the same.
- Children with additional needs will continue to be supported and receive additional support as they do now.
- We will continue to work closely with local schools across our local area.

The benefits of the proposed multi-academy trust include:

- Joining a trust, rooted in our local community, with a vision to improve outcomes for all Gosport children.
- Greater freedom to determine the school curriculum to better meet the needs of all learners.
- Increased flexibility with the school budget and cost savings to enable us to better meet the priorities of the school.
- Opportunities to improve transition and success at secondary settings for our learners.
- Capacity to further improve and exchange good practice and ideas between the schools thus improving the quality of teaching and learning for all.
- Enhanced staff development within the GFM.
